Hi Curt,

Thanks for your email. I believe the answer to your question is that Christian appears to have been referencing tests which measured leaching, not the presence of BPA. Chris is a Swiss German and English is not his native language. Additionally, he was terminated by SIGG about 2 months ago – one reason was the inaccuracies in his messages to both fellow SIGG employees as well as non-employees like you.
