Statement to Eric Rankin of the CBC

Further to our telephone call at about 3 PM today:

- General Fusion is in compliance with its City of Burnaby business license, which is for Research and Development of Alternate Energy. No fusion tests are taking place in Burnaby.
- General Fusion takes safety seriously. We have a Safety Committee, with representation from all levels of the company. As part of our regular reviews for potential safety risks, we have proactively engaged the Burnaby Fire Department, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) and our Insurer's risk prevention engineer.
- General Fusion's work has been vetted by world leading fusion experts from Canada, the USA, Europe and Russia. They all support the work and none suggest that there is an explosive or neutron public safety hazard as claimed by Erich Vogt in the CBC report.
- The movie clips that CBC aired have no connection at all to the real world of fusion research and certainly not to General Fusion's operations.
