

Canadian Missing Since 1989 Recovered From Glacier in Tyrol

Innsbruck (APA) A Canadian, who had been missing since 1989, was recovered from a crevasse of the Stubai Glacier in Tyrol yesterday, Friday. This person, who was 23 years old at the time, had plunged with his snowboard in the free skiing area.

The icy grave of the holidaymaker was located by the driver of a piste vehicle in an area belonging to the town of Neustift at altitude of 3000 meters, **120 meters east** of the "Eisjoch" ski lift. The corpse was partly surrounded by the ice of the glacier.

A snowboard and parts of clothing were found near the corpse. A purse could be found in the partly intact clothing, which contained several identity cards and business cards in the name of Duncan McPherson.

Despite sever search campaigns, the casualty could not be located in 1989. The corpse was now recovered with the help of a helicopter.
