## ORDER FOR RELEASE

I hereby order, pursuant to the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* and subject to the conditions hereunder specified the release from detention of

**Mr. Sywald SKEID**

### CONDITIONS

**That Mr. Sywald SKEID**

1. agrees to accept and keep any appointment made for him with a qualified medical practitioner for the purpose of an assessment/diagnosis concerning his stated post-concussion global amnesia along with any other medical examination deemed necessary at the time with a view to being referred to a specialist of the type noted in paragraph (b);
2. agrees to undertake a further medical assessment/diagnosis upon referral by the practitioner noted in paragraph (a) to a medical practitioner qualified to assess/diagnose post-concussion global amnesia;
3. agrees to diligently follow any instructions of either practitioner in paragraphs (a) and (b) above including submitting to any and all procedures that may be required;
4. agrees that the costs of the assessments mentioned in paragraphs (a) and (b) will be paid by the Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canadian Border Services Agency and are limited, at this time, to the costs of arriving at an assessment/diagnosis only;

5. agrees that more than one visit to either practitioner may be necessary and that any such appointments will be kept by him;
6. agrees, by authorizing in writing both practitioners in (a) and (b), to make available to Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency, in writing, the results of any and all such assessments/diagnosis along with treatment options and an opinion as to the possible outcomes resulting from treatment;
7. agrees that Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency may release to either practitioner in (a) and (b) any and all information on his file that could assist in establishing his identity;
8. agrees to make and sign, forthwith, a release authorizing the hospital in Toronto to make available to Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency and the medical practitioners referred to in (a) and (b) above any record relative to his admission, diagnosis and treatment in November 1999;
9. provides a residential address to Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency;
10. advises Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency of any change in his residential address within two working days of making the change;
11. reports in person once a month to the nearest office of Citizenship and Immigration Canada and/or the Canada Border Services Agency as directed;
12. reports when and as directed by an immigration officer for any purpose under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and/or the Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations and provides his full co-operation for any such purpose.
