### **Description of the Community Sewage Facilities**

Based on the CAIS report, sewage from the houses in the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan (Golden Lake) community is treated as follows:

- 153 houses are serviced by individual septic tanks.

### **Reason for No Visit**

The Tribal Council Advisor informed OCWA that there are no communal sewage and water services in the Algonquins of Pikwakanagan (Golden Lake) community.

An OCWA representative did not visit the site. However, an OCWA representative did speak with the Band Administration and confirmed the information in this report.
