### 1.0 Description of the Community Water Supply

The Chippewas of Aamjiwnaang (Sarnia) communal water supply is supplied by the City of Sarnia. OCWA operates the water plant. Based on the CAIS report, water to the houses in the Chippewas of Aamjiwnaang community is treated as follows:

- 843 people are serviced by a communal water system.
- 252 houses are serviced by a communal water system.

### 2.0 Description of the Community Sewage Facilities

The Chippewas of Aamjiwnaang (Sarnia) communal sewage system is supplied by the City of Sarnia. Based on the CAIS report, sewage from the houses in the Chippewas of Aamjiwnaang community is treated as follows:

- 646 people are serviced by a communal sewage system; and
- 197 people are serviced by individual septic tanks.
  
- 193 houses area serviced by a communal sewage system; and
- 59 houses are serviced individual septic tanks.

### Reason for No Visit

OCWA did not visit the community because the communal water and sewage services are supplied by the City of Sarnia. On July 18, 2001, OCWA confirmed that there are no problems with the water supplied to the City.

OCWA attempted to contact the City, but calls, as of July 19, 2001, were not returned.
