Interview of Cameron MOFFAT taken by Sgt. Mark DAVIDSON,
Sgt. Martin D'ANJOU and S/Sgt. Rob PARKER

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3712 Mark: Do you know how she was killed?

3713 CM: I have various ideas.

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3714 Mark: Okay.

3715 CM: The actual cause, I can't say.

3716 Mark: When you say you can't say, what does that mean?

3717 CM: Trying to make myself not look worse than it is here. Um, I don't know

3718 how she died. Personally. I know actions that could cause death, but I

3719 don't know exactly how she died. Which is why I asked, 'kay. Because I

3720 don't know if that's just for myself, just a comforting way, a confirmation

3721 way, as much as it to assure, like, you guys that I know the truth of things.

3722 Mark: So, that, that aspect of how she died doesn't sit well with you, does it?

3723 CM: Well, I want to know how she died.

3724 Mark: No, I, I know that. But, what you have in your mind, and the visions that

3725 you have and the thoughts that you have. This is the first time in my

3726 whole time talking that your face tells me that you do not like what you

3727 think happened.

3728 CM: What I think happened is an interesting way of putting it.

3729 Mark: Well, I said it, I try to believe what you tell me. 'Cause I think you do have

3730 the bones of being an honest person. And you said to me that, when you

3731 said, I can't say, and I asked you to clarify that, and you said I don't know.

3732 But I have, you know some stuff that happened that you think may have

3733 caused it. Or, whether-

3734 CM: And I know the order of it.

3735 Mark: Right. So, your body language, your eyes, everything. And Martin, tell me

3736 if I'm wrong, that was a very uncomfortable, that vision is uncomfortable

3737 for you, and what is in your head about that. And that tells me that I was

3738 right about you, about the level that you do have some remorse and sick

3739 feeling about what happened to Kim PROCTOR. And you know what?

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3740 I'm glad to see that. I'm glad to see that hopefully, the one camp on this
3741 investigation is right about you, that something terrible happened, you're
3742 trying to cope with it. You just don't know which way to turn. And this is
3743 what I'm talking to you about. I've expressed this to you so many times-

3744 CM: I know.

3745 Mark: -that, if it's true you don't know how she died, but you know some stuff
3746 that's happened. It's like what I said to you about, yesterday, about the
3747 burn site.

3748 CM: Yeah.

3749 Mark: To believe that you didn't light her on fire and burn her. You need to
3750 honest.

3751 CM: I, I will. Like I said, in due time.

3752 Mark: Okay. What does due time mean? What, what is that? You're, you're
3753 reverting back again. You're, you're disconnecting yourself from this
3754 whole thing again.

3755 CM: Um, not right now. Basically is what I'm trying to say.

3756 Mark: Okay. 'Cause, 'cause-

3757 CM: Before the end, but not right now.

3758 Mark: What is the end? What does that mean?

3759 CM: The end, I guess is when I'm not sitting here.

3760 Mark: I'm not sure, I, I don't understand that means ... when you're not sitting
3761 there.

3762 CM: I just can't really explain it. But it's not right now, but it's not y'know eight
3763 years from now, and be like, okay, you guys, you want to sit down, and I'll
3764 tell you ... Not such a large-

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3765 Martin: Uh, I'm sorry, I, I don't understand what you mean, ... but that's such a
3766 large-

3767 CM: You guys will know eventually, but, I'm not talking like, way in the future.

3768 Martin: In your mind, where do you have to be sitting, if you're not sitting here?

3769 CM: I don't know. That's, I don't want to interrupt.

3770 Martin: No, but it, no-

3771 CM: It, I-

3772 Martin: I'm just gonna bring it back to that. You, you just said that you know of
3773 some actions that could have caused her death. We talked about that
3774 context of the four, four charges. What do you think those are that could
3775 have led to her death?

3776 CM: Well, you talk about brutalization.

3777 Martin: Mm-hm.

3778 CM: Brutalization can lead to death. So, I don't know how she died, so I can't
3779 tell you exactly how she died.

3780 Martin: Mm-hm.

3781 CM: But, but if I knew how she died, you'd know I, it would be a lot easier for
3782 me to tell you how she died.

3783 Martin: And you, you said about this, about what brutalization is. And, and given
3784 the context again. I'm, I'm bringing this back, because this is why we're
3785 here. About the murder, the sexual assault, the unlawful confinement, the
3786 indignity of the body. Right? We talked about evidence, we ta-, uh-

3787 CM: Well, your evidence shows-

3788 Martin: Yeah.

3789 CM: -... these in order.

3790 Martin: Yeah.

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3791 CM: Would be the unlawful confinement-

3792 Martin: Mm-hm.

3793 CM: Then the brutalization.

3794 Martin: Mm-hm.

3795 CM: And then um, obviously she dies. And then the indignity part.

3796 Martin: Okay.

3797 CM: So, those are obviously the order of things.

3798 Martin: Okay, there's-

3799 (Hour 5)

3800 Martin: ... your, your order that you put it again?

3801 CM: Um, the unlawful confinement.

3802 Martin: Yeah.

3803 CM: Because you have to be confined to, obviously-

3804 Martin: Yeah.

3805 CM: -brutalize somebody for a matter of time.

3806 Martin: Right.

3807 CM: Um, the brutalization part, then the murder part and then the indignity part.

3808 Martin: Okay.

3809 Mark: There is a part missing in there.

3810 (Indecipherable)

3811 Martin: ... and, and I want to, I want to bring that, that's the point I want to make.

3812 Mark: Mm hm.

3813 Martin: Is when you talk about the brutalization part. A-, and I talk about-

3814 CM: Does brutalization, d-, does, can that occur after uh, somebody's dead?

3815 ...-

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3816 Martin: Well that would be indignity as well, right. But when I talk about, when you
3817 talk about brutalization, right, I said, it, in, or the charges, I talked about
3818 sexual assault.

3819 CM: Oh yes, sorry. Um, tell you right now-

3820 Martin: Yeah.

3821 CM: -myself and as far as I know for Kruse ... not into the whole, y'know, dead
3822 people thing. So I, I guess you'd have to go for an-

3823 Martin: You know what-

3824 CM: -unlawful confinement ...-

3825 Martin: -... and I'm gonna stop you for a second. And I'm gonna take my time to
3826 thank you there as well. Uh, because that's always a question that, that
3827 I've had. Is um-

3828 CM: Necrophilia?

3829 Martin: Necrophilia-

3830 CM: It's gross.

3831 Martin: -yeah. Okay.

3832 CM: I saw this video clip once that was on this site that I visited, Kruse sent me
3833 or whatever-

3834 Martin: Yeah.

3835 CM: -and the guy was humping a dead cow ...-

3836 Martin: Yeah. And you, and you what um, that um, that says a lot there, right?
3837 And I'm glad you told me that. Um, because then ...-

3838 CM: And it, (chuckles) it takes it from really twisted to a little less twisted.

3839 Martin: ... yeah, and because I'm, I'm going to say this as part of evidence. And,
3840 I, I was, y'know, getting to that because, Cam, um, evidence shows and I
3841 think we've talked about this with Mark and I could be wrong that, your

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3842 DNA was found inside of Kim. So when you tell me that, right, it brings a
3843 sense of relief to me, because the evidence indicates, with your DNA ...-

3844 CM: That something did, y'know, sexually occur.

3845 Martin: Exactly, exactly.

3846 Mark: So-

3847 Martin: But that, y'know, brings a, a level of comfort to me what, what you said
3848 because I was concerned about, about that.

3849 CM: No, that's really gross. (Laughs)

3850 Martin: So that, so that happened previous to death then?

3851 CM: Mmm, I'm gonna try no to incriminate myself on, for me. I, I, I, not-

3852 Martin: ...

3853 CM: -saying that something did happen for Kruse after, I'm just saying, as far
3854 as I know for myself, that nothing occurred with me after that.

3855 Martin: Okay, alright.

3856 CM: And there's more to the whole story of, how everything plays out but you
3857 know, again, not right now.

3858 Martin: Okay, but that ex-, y'know, that explains to me when we talk about the
3859 sexual assault component and your DNA being found inside of her, that-

3860 CM: Is there a different charge for Necrophilia?

3861 Martin: Go ahead Mark-

3862 Mark: ...-

3863 Martin: -I know you're waiting to say something.

3864 Mark: I was just, I'm just, I didn't catch what (chuckles) Cam asked you earlier
3865 and then all of the sudden you guys were talking. I just wanna make sure
3866 I, did, did you say that you, you and, both you and Kruse did not have sex
3867 with Kim after she was dead?

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- 3868 CM: No, I'm saying because, again, this is the whole, I don't know thing. This
3869 is, for myself-
- 3870 Mark: ...
- 3871 CM: -I can say, you know, no.
- 3872 Mark: You did not have sex with Kim after she was dead? Is that-
- 3873 CM: Yes.
- 3874 Mark: Okay, but the DNA that he's talking about would have occurred bef-, when
3875 she was still alive. Is that right?
- 3876 CM: Yes.
- 3877 Mark: Okay. Sorry, I just, I-I-I'm sorry, all of a sudden you guys were talking
3878 about something and uh, yeah, it, it would be indignant ...-
- 3879 CM: Again, I, I don't believe ...-
- 3880 Mark: That Kruse did?
- 3881 CM: Yes. But again, I can't say hundred percent this is the part of being
3882 honest in my perception.
- 3883 Mark: Yeah. Yeah, so am I, is it fair to say that you did not see Kruse having sex
3884 with her when she was dead?
- 3885 CM: I'll put it this way, I don't know, but I don't think he would have. I'm not
3886 saying he didn't. I'm saying I don't know and I don't think he did.
- 3887 Mark: But, okay, so you didn't see him doing that?
- 3888 CM: Uh, no.
- 3889 Mark: And did he tell you that he did?
- 3890 CM: No.
- 3891 Mark: Okay. Okay, that, that's-
- 3892 CM: But he didn't tell me he didn't either. I'm just ...-

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3893 Mark: No, I understand that. But, but all I'm saying is, is that you didn't actually
3894 see him having sex with her when she was dead and he didn't tell you that
3895 he did, he didn't try that to see what it was like. So, did you see him
3896 having sex when she was alive?

3897 CM: I'm not gonna say.

3898 Mark: But that explained why your DNA was in there. So that ...-

3899 CM: Was his as well?

3900 Mark: Well, we're just, before we go off that, is it, that, 'cause I know that the
3901 necrophilia was a big thing, so.

3902 Martin: Yeah.

3903 Mark: So that tells us now that the DNA that was there is, is from the sex assault
3904 when she was alive, not when she was dead.

3905 Martin: Yeah ...-

3906 Mark: Thanks for, that (chuckles), now that I know the conversation, thank you
3907 again.

3908 CM: No problem.

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5070 Martin: It's just that, y'know, within the context of what took place there, right?

5071 And, and don't get me wrong, I'll just take a s-, a step back and, if you'll

5072 allow me, i-is that, i-if you take, if you go all the way to the end where um,

5073 the bur-, the body was burned. In my experience as an investigator, right?

5074 And you'll agree with this very readily, is that, when a, a crime is

5075 committed um, a lot of the times an arson will be used to cover up the

5076 crime, right?

5077 CM: Oh yeah, sure.

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5078 Martin: So, you've told me um, y'know, that the fire did occur. Like, I mean, that's,
5079 that happened, you're aware of it, you heard it like, (sound effect), woof,
5080 it's gone, right? Now-

5081 CM: I did everything but light it and see it.

5082 Martin: Yeah, exactly. So, you take that and you say, okay, let's take a step back.
5083 What is that um, fire trying to hide?

5084 CM: All sorts of stuff.

5085 Martin: All sorts of things. Okay? Uh, and we've talked about some of that stuff,
5086 right? So, when I talk about brutalization, that's where I'm at, right? So, in
5087 that context, right? Now, it'll also be lit to destroy evidence, right?

5088 CM: Well, yeah, um, they destroy evidence like, the only thing you can't
5089 destroy is damage like, the bones and stuff.

5090 Martin: Yeah, you can't destroy that.

5091 CM: But you can't see bruises, all sorts of stuff on ...-

5092 Martin: So, the fire is left to hide the bruises uh, to hide, to destroy evidence. And
5093 you realize, though, in that destruction of evidence that you can't, you
5094 cannot hide the breaking of the bones that happened during-

5095 CM: Oh, I know that.

5096 Martin: -that brutalization, right?

5097 CM: I'm assuming bones were broken, I'm not sure.

5098 Martin: Okay. Just because of the force that was used, right?

5099 CM: I didn't see most of what you would consider the brutalization.

5100 Martin: Okay, well, and-

5101 Mark: Wh-what then, what, what, sorry, that just begs the question-

5102 CM: ...

5103 MDn: -what, what, what are you aware of that was done brutalizing.

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5104 CM: Uh, this is the part of the whole big story, right? Which I'm not gonna tell
5105 you guys right now.

5106 Martin: But you, you're into it this far now, Cam, like-

5107 CM: I know, I know, but there's still a lot that I'm not ready to tell you guys.

5108 Mark: I know and some of it's because it's gonna fall on you, I understand that.
5109 Like, I totally get that.

5110 CM: No-no-no-no-no, you guys know pretty much anything that'll fall on me.
5111 And a lot of it you don't know that actually doesn't fall on me.

5112 Mark: Okay, so why is it that you won't talk about that?

5113 CM: Because I'm not ready to talk about it. It's not that I'm trying to, y'know,
5114 keep you guys from anything that would incriminate me. You already
5115 know-

5116 Mark: Yeah, no-no, no, I understand.

5117 CM: -about sexual assault because my DNA is there. I-

5118 Mark: Yeah, well, you said you did it so, I mean, whether your DNA's there or
5119 not, you said you sexually assaulted her and that's-

5120 CM: But there's, y'know, always the why and the where and everything like that
5121 and-

5122 Mark: 'Kay, when you say where, what do you mean by where?

5123 CM: Well, you s-, the bathtub is incorrect information.

5124 Mark: Okay. Okay.

5125 CM: S-

5126 Mark: Sorry, I didn't hear that?

5127 Martin: The bathtub. Sorry-

5128 CM: Was not incorrect, it's incorrect.

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- 5129 Martin: Yeah. Oh yeah, I get that, okay. And, (sighs) yeah, but, but, so again,
5130 with that fire is, it's in, I mean, that i-is part of it, right? Is to make sure
5131 that, and there's sh-, probably other motives to that but one of the motives
5132 that's included is that destruction of, of that evidence, right?
- 5133 CM: Yeah.
- 5134 Martin: Um, uh, the bruising, the broken bones um, what was, basically, what was
5135 done to the victim. Now, (sighs), y-y'know, you're, you're taking a step
5136 back here and you're saying, y'know, uh, Martin, Mark um, I, I didn't take
5137 part in that. Well-
- 5138 CM: No, I-I expect these charges to stick. Like, I-I'm-
- 5139 Martin: Yeah. Oh, for sure.
- 5140 CM: -telling you this like-
- 5141 Martin: Yeah.
- 5142 CM: -that y-, I didn't have part of this. Like, I don't expect it just to go away
5143 'cause I'm telling you I didn't have a part in it-
- 5144 Martin: No, exactly, 'cause it doesn't go away. Um, because yeah, you do own
5145 your role, but that's all that we want you to own. (Chuckles)
- 5146 CM: Mm-hm.
- 5147 Martin: Right? Is only your role. You owned your part, Cam. You know that.
5148 You're smart enough to understand it. You, you know that what you own-
- 5149 CM: Okay, but you know, I told you guys I didn't light that body on fire or
5150 anything, right?
- 5151 Martin: Yeah.
- 5152 CM: But I would still get, y'know, the whole um, what do you call that? Uh, the
5153 indecency-
- 5154 Martin: Oh, f-, f-

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5155 CM: -to a body.

5156 Martin: Yeah, absolutely, because you're a party to that offence, right? I mean,
5157 you're the guy who goes out and purchases the fuel and you bring the
5158 body over to that site. Yeah, I agree, right? Because we all own our each
5159 part, but that's all that, that, that is all that we want you to own. Y'know
5160 what I'm saying?

5161 CM: Yeah.

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6443 Martin: 'Kay? Now, I'm gonna bring you back into um, the components of what

6444 we talked about, right? The unlawful confinement, sexual assault um, the

6445 murder and then the, the indignity. We've already talked about the

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6446 unlawful confinement, right? About your DNA. When we talk about the
6447 murder or the, actually, let's start with the sexual assault. Um, I've already
6448 told you that your DNA was found inside of her.
6449 (DAVIDSON enters room)
6450 Martin: So, if I go with that, I want you to take, just to bring you back to the same
6451 exercise that we just did. Take stock in your mind. Okay?
6452 CM: For the murder?
6453 Martin: Yeah, uh, no. For the sexual assault.
6454 CM: Oh, I see what you're sayin' now.
6455 Martin: Okay? So, take stock in your mind. Where do you think your DNA is
6456 present?
6457 CM: Um, I know where it is. Uh, I know where, I don't wanna verbalize it, but I
6458 know where it-
6459 Martin: Well-
6460 CM: -where it would be.
6461 Martin: Well-
6462 CM: Where the only place-
6463 Martin: -you tell me where it would be.
6464 CM: Uh-
6465 Martin: You tell me the only place it could be.
6466 CM: I don't wanna verbalize it.
6467 Martin: I'm not gonna put words in your mouth.
6468 CM: I know you're not gonna put words in my mouth.
6469 Martin: Okay.
6470 CM: I know where it is.
6471 Martin: Where is it?

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6472 CM: I don't wanna-

6473 Martin: Where is that DNA?

6474 CM: I'm not verbalizing.

6475 Martin: Cameron, where is that DNA?

6476 CM: I know where it is. I'm not verbalizing it.

6477 Martin: Okay, I, like I said, I'm not gonna put words in your mouth.

6478 CM: I know you're not gonna put words in my mouth.

6479 Martin: Where is that DNA?

6480 CM: I'm not gonna say. I-I'm not expecting you to say. I'm just not gonna say.

6481 Martin: 'Kay. C-, but I, I'm asking you, where, where is it?

6482 CM: I know you're asking. I'm not gonna say.

6483 Martin: Okay. In, speaking in general terms, where is it?

6484 CM: Lower regions.

6485 Martin: Lower regions.

6486 CM: Yeah.

6487 Mark: Point to it, point where it would be on a woman.

6488 CM: I'm not gonna, (chuckles), it's no different if I say it and if it's on video.

6489 Martin: Okay, so you're saying lower regions.

6490 CM: Yeah.

6491 Martin: Okay. Can I keep going or did you need to interject here?

6492 Mark: Uh, all I was just, gonna just, why I left.

6493 Martin: 'Kay.

6494 Mark: Just uh, just say, is uh, you had said to me yesterday that you smoke.

6495 You smoke-

6496 CM: I-I do.

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6497 Mark: -right? Yeah. And uh, I-I realize that you've been here for quite awhile
6498 and, and I was gonna offer you a t-, y'know, would you like a cigarette,
6499 because you've been quite awhile, and I used to smoke I know what it's
6500 like. But I wanted to make sure there was no rules in the building that's-
6501 Martin: Oh.
6502 Mark: -good, so, anyway. If uh, if you'd be interested in a cigarette I can get
6503 someone to make that happen.
6504 CM: In here? Can you do that?
6505 Mark: I'm sorry?
6506 CM: Can you do that in here? (Chuckles)
6507 Mark: Yeah, it's not gonna blow up or anything. But uh, if you're interested in
6508 that we'll, I'll-I'll make that happen. I know you've been here for a long
6509 time and, like, two days now in here and no cigarettes so.
6510 CM: Sure.
6511 Mark: But uh, if you don't-
6512 CM: I have some-
6513 Mark: -if you don't want-
6514 CM: -I have some in my possession still.
6515 Mark: Oh, do you? Oh, I didn't realize you, 'cause you said you hid them from
6516 your dad so I thought maybe you didn't have any with you.
6517 CM: No, I wasn't with my dad when I was-
6518 Mark: Oh, okay, then I'll ... tell him to grab 'em from there. Sorry.
6519 (DAVIDSON exits room)
6520 Martin: Okay. So, I'm just gonna go back 'cause we've been kinda jumpin' around
6521 so, when we talked about the unlawful confinement um, you took stock in,
6522 in some of those items. Right?

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6523 CM: I think you've seen my face after what ...

6524 Martin: Okay, and then you kind of prioritize them, right? As to where it would be
6525 found.

6526 CM: If I was to tell you exactly what happened, I could tell you something and
6527 um, all this, you can make them to believe it, uh, th-, but there's always
6528 that one piece that pushes it over the edge. Like uh, you can get told a
6529 story, right?

6530 Martin: Mm-hm.

6531 CM: You may never believe it-

6532 Martin: Mm.

6533 CM: -until you, like, hear this one thing. Or you remember this one thing, and
6534 that pushes that story, and that's what makes you believe it.

6535 Martin: Right.

6536 CM: There's one thing that, y'know, makes me believe everything you're telling
6537 me and it's not just, y'know, a joke.

6538 Martin: Yeah, yeah, 'cause I, I-I mean, I wouldn't waste my time doing that. I think
6539 you've, you, in getting to know me here today y-you'd kinda see that,
6540 right?

6541 CM: Yeah.

6542 Martin: I'm not gonna, I not gonna blow smoke up your ass. It's not what I'm here
6543 to do. So, we've ta-, taken stock on the unlawful confinement, and you
6544 kinda prioritize those as s-, um, your DNA would probably be found on,
6545 could be found on, in your priority, something sticky, a piece of clothing, or
6546 another item. Right? Um, for the DNA regarding the sexual assault, you
6547 believe that it would be found in her lower uh, region, lower area. Now, if

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6548 we get to the murder. Um, and you take stock, and I told you the way that
6549 she was killed, right?
6550 CM: Yeah.
6551 Martin: Now, take stock in, in all those items that facilitated that.
6552 CM: The suffocation.
6553 Martin: Yeah.
6554 CM: Asphyxiation.
6555 Martin: Exactly.
6556 CM: Was your word.
6557 Martin: So, take stock in all those items.
6558 CM: Okay.
6559 Martin: And is your DNA found on any of those items?
6560 CM: Sweat maybe, if anything.
6561 Martin: On what item?
6562 CM: I can't tell you exactly what asphyxiated her, so-
6563 Martin: Okay. So, take stock in, again, those items that aided in that
6564 asphyxiation-
6565 CM: Not all of them are items.
6566 Martin: Okay, you're right. So, take stock in, I know not all of them are items.
6567 Take stock in those items-
6568 CM: I-I know exactly happened-
6569 Martin: 'Kay.
6570 CM: -and with what.
6571 Martin: So prioritize those. Which item, which item do you think your DNA's on?
6572 CM: The only physical item that was used, it would be the only thing and it
6573 wouldn't be from using it.

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6574 Martin: You lost me.

6575 CM: There would only be one thing that she was asphyxiated with.

6576 Martin: Okay.

6577 CM: But that would be a physical item that, y'know, was an item, not a person.

6578 Martin: Okay. So you're-

6579 CM: And uh-

6580 Martin: -so you're saying that she was, a-and I get stuck in what you just said,

6581 right? You're just saying that she was um, asphyxiated with force.

6582 Because you say that it's an item and a person.

6583 CM: Kruse.

6584 Martin: Okay, so you're saying to me that Kruse asphyxiated her.

6585 CM: Could've been. Could've.

6586 Martin: Okay. But i-, in essence, you said, I-I tell you what the cause of death is,

6587 it's asphyxiation.

6588 CM: Yeah.

6589 Martin: Right?

6590 CM: Yeah.

6591 Martin: And you tell me it's an item and a person.

6592 CM: Or a person.

6593 Martin: Okay. Well, there's two, there's two people there.

6594 CM: Yeah.

6595 Martin: There's you, and there's Kruse.

6596 CM: Yeah.

6597 Martin: Right? So, I want you to really think, though, (chuckles), about

6598 suffocation. And look at that whole picture, right? What item would have

6599 your DNA on it?

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6600 CM: I know what you're referring to, again, the whole vocalizing thing.

6601 Martin: Okay, well just, wh-where do you think? Make that list again like we did

6602 on unlawful confinement.

6603 CM: I did s-

6604 Martin: Make that list again.

6605 CM: I, I'm not gonna vocalize it, but I know what you're talking about, yeah. It

6606 wouldn't be on that like, other than, not that, not for the use. Like, that, my

6607 DNA would've not been put on it to a prior or after, or prior or during use, I

6608 should say.

6609 Martin: During or prior what?

6610 CM: During, or y-, during or before the use of it. So, when it was just a

6611 mundane object, or-

6612 Martin: Okay.

6613 CM: -the use of it. Uh, my DNA would not be transferred to it.

6614 Martin: Okay.

6615 CM: That I can see.

6616 Martin: Okay. What about during?

6617 CM: I just said during uh, during the use of it. I don't mean prior, I accidentally

6618 said that.

6619 Martin: Oh, oh, okay. 'Cause you, you kinda confused me with the prior and

6620 during. So, during-

6621 CM: Before n-, I, sh-shouldn't, I don't see any reason. I can't recollect having

6622 ever come in contact with it.

6623 Martin: Okay.

6624 CM: During the use, can't recollect ever coming in contact with it. Uh I, I know I

6625 didn't come in contact with it during use.

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6626 Martin: Okay.

6627 CM: And then after, I may have come in contact with it, because it was still
6628 present ...

6629 Martin: Okay. So, still present. Okay. And just so I, I-I, okay, le-let's do this. So,
6630 I can talk about, again, your credibility, 'cause I'm not gonna put words in
6631 your mouth, right? If we talk about that item and I wanna ascertain if that's
6632 the same one that your DNA is on. Without you specifically having to tell
6633 me what that, that item is what colour is that item?

6634 CM: Oh God, this isn't gonna work. Um, there's two things that are the same
6635 colour that I would believe would be present.

6636 Martin: So that, that's, that makes it difficult, isn't it?

6637 CM: Mm-hm. You know-

6638 Martin: So there's-

6639 CM: -you should know items would be present, left behind from where, the face
6640 area that I was shown, right?

6641 Martin: Yeah. Okay, so from that, s-so from that area, you say that there's two
6642 items that are uh, of the same colour. Okay. Now the one that you're
6643 talking about, that doesn't uh, that you say that you had no contact with-

6644 CM: Prior, or during.

6645 Martin: Prior or during. Is one of uh, i-is one of those items that you're talking
6646 about.

6647 CM: Should be. I-, the-the only recollection I know, I had no contact with it
6648 during use.

6649 Martin: Okay.

6650 CM: And I'm pretty sure I had no contact with it prior.

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6651 Martin: But you said that possibly after because it was still there. Wa-, like, wh-
6652 why is that?
6653 CM: Again, this is the whole ... the big picture thing.
6654 Martin: Yeah.
6655 CM: It was still around.
6656 Martin: It was still around. You know I'm marking towards your credibility here,
6657 eh? That's, that's where I'm going. So, I-I can't put words in your mouth.
6658 CM: I know.
6659 Martin: I-I'm not, I'm not gonna do that. I'm just working towards that. So, okay,
6660 so-
6661 CM: I don't know if this makes it m-, more useful, other than the colour, it
6662 covers more mass. If that mass is-
6663 Martin: So, alright, let's go down that road, let's talk about size then. So, out of
6664 those two items of similar colour, right? Would you say, which uh-
6665 CM: The lighter in colour and the one that covers more mass. Like um, some
6666 one covers this much, it would cover y'know, way more.
6667 Martin: Okay.
6668 CM: Not takes up mass but covers the area.
6669 Martin: Okay, a-and, so you're saying that tho-, that two items have that similar
6670 colour. What is that colour?
6671 CM: Grey.
6672 Martin: Grey. Okay.
6673 CM: As far as I can re-, recollect.
6674 Martin: Okay, and the colour of the other items?
6675 CM: I think it was black.
6676 Martin: Okay. Black.

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6677 CM: Which would be the piece of clothing.

6678 Martin: Okay, right. Okay. So, and then, a-and I'm just gonna go back to that,

6679 right? So, when we talk about, 'cause you said yo-, your list was

6680 something sticky, a piece of clothing and-

6681 CM: My third is the f-, one you're talking about with uh, I don't know-

6682 Martin: So, it's the same colour as-

6683 CM: The first.

6684 Martin: Which is something sticky. So, in your list of something sti-sticky, a piece

6685 of clothing, which you've told me is black, and then the other item which is

6686 grey as well. Um, that's how you put your uh, possibility of your DNA.

6687 CM: Mm-hm.

6688 Martin: Is um, okay. So, the, 'kay so you put your DNA on possibly on something

6689 sticky, possibly the clothing. And then the other one you said to me, which

6690 is grey, covers an area of, of more-

6691 CM: Greater mass than anything else.

6692 Martin: Of greater mass than anything else. Okay. And that's the one that's at

6693 the bottom of your list of, of least concern when it came to the unlawful

6694 confinement.

6695 CM: That should be stuck on, yeah. For unlawful confinement, yes. Um, it

6696 should, not be there. It was not really, oh, (sigh), this is hard to explain

6697 without the other things. Some things were added later. Like, the-the-the

6698 third item was added later. Not by myself. I was not there for the

6699 application, well, I was near, but not-

6700 Martin: Okay, alright, okay. So, that's starts, startin' to makes a little bit of sense

6701 for me, then. So you, you're saying that uh, something sticky and the

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6702 piece of clothing were initially placed there. And then after tha, the third
6703 piece, the one that covers more mass was applied.

6704 CM: Mmm.

6705 Martin: Okay. And you're saying that um, I wanna get this straight, is that you
6706 were not the one who applied that third piece, but you observed it being
6707 applied. Right? That's what you just said. Okay. Alright. Okay.

6708 CM: Well, for part of it I was present.

6709 Martin: For part of it you were present. Where were you the rest of the time?

6710 CM: Um, out of the area.

6711 Martin: Okay, so out of the garage?

6712 CM: No.

6713 Martin: Okay.

6714 CM: I-I'm not saying where in the house anything was done.

6715 Martin: Okay.

6716 CM: But I-I was not in the same, I was not in viewing distance.

6717 Martin: You weren't in viewing distance of that. Okay. Alright. So, what you're
6718 saying is that if she was in Kruse's room at the time, you would've have
6719 been outside the room.

6720 CM: Or if she was in the bathroom, the hallway, anywhere.

6721 Martin: Wherever she was, you weren't present in that, in the, in there when that
6722 third piece, that your of least concern on your list, was applied. Okay. So-

6723 CM: You know by what you found that the three items I refer to were still there,
6724 after.

6725 Martin: Yes. Yeah, yeah. What you're saying is right. Those, those three items
6726 that you referred to were still there. Okay.

6727 CM: As well as I, I was not again present for this-

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6728 Martin: Yeah.

6729 CM: -but I know um, there might've been other items left that um, were in the
6730 same vicinity to Kruse's DNA. This I was told by Kruse.

6731 Mark: Sorry, you-you lost me there.

6732 CM: Um, there may be other items, besides what was used for unlawful
6733 restraint and-

6734 Mark: Yeah.

6735 CM: Of course the aphy-,uh, the asphyxiation-

6736 Mark: Yeah.

6737 CM: -that were left there by Kruse.

6738 Mark: Okay, that were left where?

6739 CM: In the vicinity of Kruse's DNA. Which was not on, y'know, the bindings, or
6740 whatever.

6741 Martin: Okay. When you say bindings, what do you mean by that?

6742 CM: Well, you're te-, saying unlawful confinement. And the only thing you have
6743 left out is bindings.

6744 Martin: Okay, so tell me about that then.

6745 CM: What, the bindings?

6746 Martin: Yeah.

6747 CM: I'm not gonna say anything about that. I'm just telling you that I know
6748 Kruse may have placed other items on or otherwise with uh, regards to
6749 Kim.

6750 Martin: Okay um, and I c-, and I'll bring that back to um, what you've uh, what
6751 you've talked about before of uh, positioning. In the fetal position. We
6752 talked about lithotomy position and things like that. So, um, so, and when

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6753 we talk about the positioning of the bindings um, what would that have
6754 looked like.
6755 CM: Can't say.
6756 Martin: W-
6757 (Hour 8)
6758 CM: Uh, I can go until you, you know, you'd typically what you would bind
6759 somebody, or how, or-
6760 Martin: Okay. What's typical uh, what do you mean by typical? Let's just take
6761 that-
6762 CM: I-if you're gonna restrain anything you know, like, um, shackles in prison
6763 you know.
6764 Martin: Alright.
6765 CM: Legs and arms and like, when you hog-tie a hog, you use ex-ex-
6766 extremities.
6767 Martin: Okay. So, but y-y-you and I get that, but what did you mean by typical
6768 restraints?
6769 CM: Well, that is typical of any animal with extremities is you bind its
6770 extremities. That would be typical.
6771 Martin: Okay, so what you're saying is, i-is binding feet and, and binding uh, arms
6772 or?
6773 CM: Any extremities um, in an octopus you got eight arms and-
6774 Martin: (Chuckles)
6775 CM: -if you don't want an octopus to get away, you restrain his tentacles.
6776 Martin: Okay.
6777 CM: Or all of his extremities 'cause he can't really use his head to get away.

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6778 Martin: Okay, right. And uh, so, in this case, what's used as, as the binding
6779 material?
6780 CM: Can't tell you.
6781 Martin: Why is that?
6782 CM: Mm, just because.
6783 Martin: Okay. But it would, i-it would be part and parcel to that unlawful
6784 confinement, right?
6785 CM: It'd be number-
6786 Martin: So, something sticky? Okay.
6787 CM: Which you and me both know what it is.
6788 Martin: Pardon?
6789 CM: You and me both know what it is.
6790 Martin: Yeah, we do. Absolutely. Absolutely. Okay. Okay. So, that is used um,
6791 when we talk about unlawful confinement, it's used um, that causes that
6792 preservation to the face?
6793 CM: I'm not sure if it was that that did that. I think that'd be number three that
6794 did that because um, there shouldn't have been number one anywhere
6795 near that.
6796 Martin: Okay.
6797 CM: Not upper part. That's where number three should be.
6798 Martin: Okay. So you're, a-and I'm not showin' this to gross you out here, right?
6799 CM: Yeah.
6800 Martin: Um, and, and I, I'll just, you can see that the whole, the whole area is
6801 preserved.
6802 CM: This not so much, though. It's-
6803 Martin: Down here?

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6804 CM: -yeah.

6805 Martin: Okay. So, why isn't that as preserved as, as this?

6806 CM: I don't know.

6807 Martin: Okay, 'cause you're s-, you're saying that item number one, which was
6808 something sticky, can we get past that?

6809 CM: (Chuckles) Okay, let's just say it was covering this. That's the only thing
6810 that might, seem to my knowledge that it should've been covering on m-

6811 Martin: Okay. Is, is lower? Is what, when you say, when you say covering this,
6812 you say, this up, or this down?

6813 CM: Um, when Kruse applied the third-

6814 Martin: Okay.

6815 CM: Th-the only knowledge I had um, was of s-stuff covering her mouth.

6816 Martin: Okay. Alright. That makes sense. That makes sense what you're saying.
6817 So, what you're saying is that, when I ask you the question, is it here up or
6818 here down, you're saying that-

6819 CM: Here down.

6820 Martin: -item number one-

6821 CM: Is there down.

6822 Martin: Is there down. Item number two?

6823 CM: (Makes motion)

6824 Martin: Okay. And item number three, which is the one of more mass?

6825 CM: Would be covering everything.

6826 Martin: Would be covering everything. So, we're talking and it, and that's what
6827 causes the preservation in your mind?

6828 CM: I'm assuming because everything is m-, but in standards of what I can
6829 assume the rest of it's like preserved.

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6830 Martin: Okay.

6831 CM: One would say.

6832 Martin: Now, do you think that item three would actually allow for that preservation
6833 to occur?

6834 CM: No, I can't see how but, it's the only explanation. ...

6835 Martin: Okay. So item number one you say is from here down. Item number two,
6836 you pointed into your mouth.

6837 CM: Th-this is where I-I'm assuming. I wasn't there at the time of-

6838 Martin: Okay.

6839 CM: -all of this.

6840 Martin: But we talked about items number one-

6841 CM: M-mostly we ...-

6842 Martin: -and liems number three being of a grey colour.

6843 CM: Yeah.

6844 Martin: And we talked about the item where you pointed into your mouth being of
6845 uh-

6846 CM: Okay, let's just get back to that, it's Kruse's sock.

6847 Martin: Okay.

6848 CM: Which is why I find it hard to believe that his DNA was not present.

6849 Martin: Okay. Can I check on that?

6850 CM: That it was a sock?

6851 ET 00:04:32

6852 Martin: No, that a-a-about his DNA.

6853 CM: Sure. Go for it.

6854 Martin: I can?

6855 CM: Yeah.

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6856 Martin: Okay. I wa-, 'cause I wanna make wholeheartedly sure.
6857 CM: It's his sock.
6858 Martin: Okay. So you, that's why you figured-
6859 CM: That's-
6860 Martin: -his DNA's on it.
6861 CM: -that's why-
6862 Martin: I wanna make sure-
6863 CM: Yeah.
6864 Martin: -that there's, that there isn't a DNA profile for that.
6865 CM: Okay.
6866 Martin: Because if there is, I wanna let you know that.
6867 CM: Okay.
6868 Martin: Okay. Give me a second.
6869 (D'ANJOU exits room)
6870 CM: (Groans. Sighs. Burps)
6871 (D'ANJOU enters room)
6872 Martin: Okay. Okay, so that black item.
6873 CM: Yeah.
6874 Martin: Kruse's sock. There is DNA on there.
6875 CM: You guys said there was no DNA evidence.
6876 Martin: No-no. No-no. No.
6877 CM: Uh, outside. I guess that is inside, though.
6878 Martin: Yeah. And that's, a-a-and that's where it, where it lies, Cam. Right?
6879 That's, that's exactly where it lies. So, what I'm, what I'm gonna do is, and
6880 I wanna make sure of that, right? Um, so I, I-I made sure on the DNA. No
6881 doubt. Okay? Kruse's DNA is on that item. But when I was, when I'm

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6882 talkin' about that, okay, I want you to, to take stock in knowing this, we've
6883 gone over how uh, th-the, the different things, right? When we talk about
6884 uh, unlawful confinement, we talk about sexual assault and murder.
6885 Right? Now, I'm not gonna make any leaps, right? But if, as you told me,
6886 right? There's a sock there-

6887 CM: I categorize that as the unlawful confinement part d-due to the restraining
6888 voice.

6889 Martin: Due, due to what, sorry?

6890 CM: Restraining voice. It wasn't used for asphyxiation or anything like that.

6891 Martin: Oh, okay. Okay. So that-

6892 CM: Like, that's un-, that's unless you put like, a, a ball.

6893 Martin: Right.

6894 CM: So.

6895 Martin: Yeah, okay. So, okay. Alright. So, in your, in-in your uh, mind when I
6896 ask, when I asked you that-

6897 CM: That was in my mind ...-

6898 Martin: Okay. So what, a-and you, I think you just said it, you're, what was the,
6899 the purpose of, of that sock then?

6900 CM: To muffle sound.

6901 Martin: Okay.

6902 CM: Like, he took it off his foot and you know. (Sound effect)

6903 Martin: Okay. Alright.

6904 CM: And then, y'know, I was yelled at to grab number one.

6905 Martin: Okay.

6906 CM: Which he had placed, he, at his convenience nearby.

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6907 Martin: Okay. And that Item number one is the sticky which you're, you
6908 considered to be at the top of your list.

6909 CM: Because that's-

6910 Martin: Because-

6911 CM: -when I grabbed for-

6912 Martin: Okay. I-I mean, yeah and let's stop beating around the bush on that, eh?
6913 You told me it was grey, you told me it's sticky. It's recovered, what is it?

6914 CM: (Chuckles) You tell me.

6915 Martin: Well, I, I don't wanna put words in your mouth, what is it?

6916 CM: (Laughs) I don't wanna put words in yours.

6917 Martin: Okay. Alright. So, but y-you know where I was going with that, and that's
6918 why I, I didn't uh, mention it as that, i-is because-

6919 CM: Yeah.

6920 Martin: -I was thinking of it as, because I asked you-

6921 CM: No-no number-

6922 Martin: -to take stock-

6923 CM: -number three was the m-, just, m-, number three wasn't the restraint, it's
6924 the only thing that wasn't the restraint.

6925 Martin: Okay. And your intent uh, the intent with number two which is uh, Kruse's
6926 sock that he takes off his foot, is in your view to do what?

6927 CM: Muffle sound.

6928 Martin: Okay.

6929 CM: That's-

6930 Martin: So, that's why we don't compartmentalize it with-

6931 CM: M-, the-

6932 Martin: With the, the murder.

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6933 CM: Yes.

6934 Martin: Because of, of um, you don't think that that cause at that point, and I can
6935 see now why you said, oh this is gonna cause a problem when I talked to
6936 you about the cause of death because you're kinda wonderin' that, and
6937 that's where the lines get blurred, I guess, right? The lines get blurred
6938 there as to um, what caused the asphyxiation, suffocation as to what
6939 causes the unlawful confinement. That'd be-

6940 CM: Which is why I didn't categorize it because here down was covered and
6941 just restrained um, here down so, m-, the nose and, there's no air
6942 passageway blockage, so I wasn't categorizing that as the cause of
6943 asphyxiation.

6944 Martin: I see. Okay. So, at the t-, at the time that she's in the residence then at
6945 that point then it's uh-

6946 CM: After Kruse has, he taped his sock there and stuff.

6947 Martin: Yeah.

6948 CM: He used tape.

6949 Martin: Yeah. So, what kind of tape?

6950 CM: Duct Tape.

6951 Martin: Duct Tape. Okay. So, after Kruse Duct Tapes the sock in there. 'Kay so
6952 she's in, and that's what, and I can see why you're not, why your thinking
6953 is it's unlaw-, that's part of the, on one of the items to unlawful
6954 confinement because it doesn't, i-, y-you, you say that it's just from here
6955 down at that point. Right? So, the tape is, is where?

6956 CM: Mmm, the lips.

6957 Martin: Okay. A-and the sock is in the mouth to suppress that voice. Is that right?

6958 CM: That's, yeah.

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6959 Martin: Suppress sound. Okay. He takes it right off his foot?
6960 CM: It's the only place that I figure he could get a sock from at the moment.
6961 Martin: A-a, really quick like that, yeah. Okay.
6962 CM: You given the location which I'm not gonna disclose.
6963 Martin: Mm-hm, mm-hm. Right. So, right at that time probably not right in his
6964 bedroom 'cause that would be more readily accessible than say the
6965 kitchen.
6966 CM: Yeah.
6967 Martin: Correct? So, you're d-, you're deducing that, 'kay well that's where the
6968 sock comes from is right off his foot because of the fact that we're not in
6969 his bedroom at that time, we're, we're somewhere else in the house.
6970 Right?
6971 CM: Yes, but it is his sock. It's not mine, mine were on my feet.
6972 Martin: Okay. Alright. Okay. And that's why I was compartmentalized by the
6973 unlawful confinement DNA compared to the murder DNA, but with your
6974 explanation then that makes it part of the, it meshes it back to the, our first
6975 charge of unlawful confinement, right? Okay? That makes sense. Okay.
6976 Alright. Um, okay. Now, I-I'm kinda puzzled as to, you, you say that item
6977 number three covers more mass.
6978 CM: There can only be three items in, the profile of that area-
6979 Martin: Yeah.
6980 CM: -it should've been present, as far as my knowledge goes.
6981 Martin: Okay. So we went, went through one and two, 'kay? So, number one
6982 was uh, the Duct Tape. Number two is the sock, and what is number
6983 three?
6984 CM: I believe Kruse grabbed a Walmart bag off his counter.

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6985 Martin: Okay.

6986 CM: This is why I say it's grey.

6987 Martin: Same colour as the Duct Tape a, so you-you-you think it's a-a Walmart
6988 bag?

6989 CM: Yeah, Kruse grabbed some bag, I'm pretty sure it's grey.

6990 Martin: Okay.

6991 CM: Like I said, I didn't stick around in the room 'cause I've, I've, there was, I
6992 don't want any part of that.

6993 Martin: It's mayhem right then, right?

6994 CM: Yeah.

6995 Martin: So, when that's happenin', what's goin' through your head?

6996 CM: Uh, m-, t-, everything. A m-million miles an hour.

6997 Martin: Oh, yeah.

6998 CM: It's like, what the fuck.

6999 Martin: Oh yeah. And-and how do you feel inside?

7000 CM: Uh, you got the biggest adrenalin rush you've ever have 'cause it's, what
7001 the fuck.

7002 Martin: Yeah. Absolutely. I g-, I-I, yeah. I can't ima-, I've had adrenalin rushes
7003 but I-I can imagine that this is a huge adrenalin dump, eh?

7004 CM: Not in a good way either like, when you're doin' somethin' like, physical
7005 and it's uh, intense-

7006 Martin: Yeah.

7007 CM: -you know adrenalin it's a-

7008 Martin: Mm-hm.

7009 CM: -oh, that was such a, y'know, good rush.

7010 Martin: Yeah.

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7011 CM: I love doin' that and this is just like, the adrenalin where it's like, oh my
7012 frickin' God, and you like, puke your guts out and-

7013 Martin: Fight or flight. Have you ever experienced that before?

7014 CM: Yeah.

7015 Martin: So, this is probably the biggest event of fight or flight in your whole life?

7016 CM: (Chuckles) Probably.

7017 Martin: Yeah. Well, I can see that. Um, so when he grabs this Walmart bag, this
7018 bag that you call um, how's it placed on there?

7019 CM: Just, I don't know, your mother when you were little told you not to put
7020 bags over your head, m-, that's the reason. (Chuckle)

7021 Martin: Yeah, okay. Okay. So, is the bag uh, placed over like, just like, uh-

7022 CM: Like, from the extent of my-

7023 Martin: -your mom tells you not to do?

7024 CM: -knowledge it was just placed over and then taped by Kruse.

7025 Martin: Sorry, I didn't hear it in the beginning.

7026 CM: The pla-, from the extent of my knowledge it was just pulled over and
7027 taped by Kruse around her head.

7028 Martin: Okay.

7029 CM: I believe Kruse was in there for some time before he taped it but, which is
7030 again why I don't know how she was asphyxiated. There is still a whole
7031 lot more to the asphyxiation story, etcetera, etcetera, etcetera.

7032 Martin: Yeah.

7033 CM: That I haven't, y'know, disclosed.

7034 Martin: Yeah. But you, you know what, Cam, I-I really appreciate you clarifying
7035 those points for me 'cause y-you know, when I go through um, those
7036 charges and-and we had kind of a little, y'know, uh, little problems ascer-,

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7037 and that's why I wanted to be clear, right? It's ascertaining about what
7038 was the component in the unlawful confinement c-c-concerning the
7039 component to the, to that, that act of, of a-asphyxiation cause I told you
7040 what that, that was the cause of death is. Um, so going over that is now
7041 the bag is kinda placed over her head, like our moms always told us not to
7042 do as we were growing up. And then you say that it's, that it's taped as
7043 well?
7044 CM: As far as I knew.
7045 Martin: Okay. So, a-and, and how do you come about that knowledge? Like
7046 that? 'Cause at, at one point you would've seen Kim in, in that state,
7047 right? With uh-
7048 CM: Not that I was really (chuckles) looking.
7049 Martin: Okay. Alright. So, that happens and, and the bag is, is taped around her
7050 head?
7051 CM: As far as I know.
7052 Martin: Okay. So how much t-tape is used to, to secure that bag on there?
7053 CM: Um, uh, the bag I don't know um, mmm, p-, as far as I know almost a
7054 whole roll of Duct Tape was gone at the end.
7055 Martin: Okay.
7056 CM: 'Cause um, at one point uh, Kruse told me um, to remove the restraints.
7057 Martin: Okay.
7058 CM: And I did so and then left.
7059 Martin: Okay. Alright. Um, oh, and I wanna take you back to something that you
7060 said, is that um, Kruse takes his sock off and he puts it in her mouth.
7061 CM: I'm, I'm not sayin' he did take his sock off, I'm just sayin' that's the only
7062 way I could see it being readily available.

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7063 Martin: Alright, okay. So, Kruse's sock ends up in Kim's mouth. But then you
7064 said to me that you were told to grab something that would be in the
7065 vicinity of Kruse, Kruse's DNA, which is at that point, what you lead me to
7066 believe is, what we talked about that uh, what the s-sticky thing was,
7067 which is the Duct Tape, correct?

7068 CM: Yeah, Duct Tape.

7069 Martin: Okay. So, does he hand it to you, or?

7070 CM: I had to go get it. He told me where it was.

7071 Martin: Okay. So, you go and get it and you come back. And what, what are you
7072 told to do?

7073 CM: Just tape her legs.

7074 Martin: Okay.

7075 CM: And then I just opened up more tape and handed it to him.

7076 Martin: Okay. So, first off you tape her legs, and where, where do you tape them?

7077 CM: Just like, I was told to do it around the legs. Just-

7078 Martin: Okay.

7079 CM: J-, (sighs), I can't tell you exactly where.

7080 Martin: Okay. So-

7081 CM: Just the lower ankle-

7082 Martin: Lower-

7083 CM: -area.

7084 Martin: Okay. So, you taped her legs and then you uh, like, you showed me right
7085 there, you opened a-a piece of tape for him that you give to him? And
7086 what does he do with that piece of tape?

7087 CM: Uh, bound her hands, I believe.

7088 Martin: Okay.

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7089 CM: (Sighs)

7090 Martin: Um, so now her um, her feet are, are, and I-, and her lower extremities are

7091 bound, her ha-, her hands are being bound. How are they bound?

7092 CM: With the tape.

7093 Martin: Okay. And in what position?

7094 CM: Uh, I think her hands were behind her back.

7095 Martin: Hands behind her back? Okay. And so, the tape goes on there and do

7096 you provide him with more tape?

7097 CM: Mm, j-, at that point I'm just listening to whatever he says 'cause-

7098 Martin: Okay. So, what does he say to you?

7099 CM: He's just, he, tape 'em, yelling at me to make sure people aren't around,

7100 whatever. Like uh, when his parole officer phoned. He's like, go see who

7101 the fuck's here etcetera etcetera etcetera.

7102 Martin: Okay. Was the parole officer at the door?

7103 CM: I didn't see her.

7104 Martin: Okay. But you-you say that she phoned?

7105 CM: She did phone and then um, s-somebody knocked at the door and I'm

7106 assuming it was the parole officer or-

7107 Martin: Okay. And did you go, when he tells you to go check, did you go check?

7108 CM: I went and looked and nobody was there.

7109 Martin: There was no one there?

7110 CM: No.

7111 Martin: So, somebody had knocked on the door when all this was going on?

7112 Okay. Now when you go and he yells at you, go check and stuff like that,

7113 you don't see anybody, what happens after that?

7114 CM: I just stayed out of the room. I didn't want part of it.

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7115 Martin: Okay. Alright. So, um, when we talk about, and this has become a bit
7116 clearer for me here now, when we talk about the unlawful confinement um,
7117 and your concern being number one which is the duct tape for your DNA-
7118 CM: 'Cause that's what I had.
7119 Martin: That's what you had and, and that's what you had in your uh, in your
7120 hands? Okay. Um, now you say that the tape was from here down. What
7121 role did you play in-in taping from here down?
7122 CM: Mmm, just pulling the tape up, just openin' it up.
7123 Martin: Just opening it up? And then-
7124 CM: Opening it up um, the first one-
7125 Martin: And when, and so-
7126 CM: -the first one was cut, so it should've been a shorter piece.
7127 Martin: Okay.
7128 CM: I had, had handled that and um, of course I was handling it because he
7129 had to hold-
7130 Martin: Okay.
7131 CM: -her and so I did, he would, couldn't operate fully, so I did assist him.
7132 Martin: Okay. So, when you um, take that first piece, you cut it, is that the first
7133 one that's applied to her mouth?
7134 CM: I believe so.
7135 Martin: Is the cut piece?
7136 CM: I believe so.
7137 Martin: Okay. And then from there when you say you uh, pull out ta-, or, I forget
7138 the term that we were just using, so we're clear, you've got the roll in one
7139 hand, you're stretching it out, cutting a piece.

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- 7140 CM: No, I don't think I was cutting at that point. I think I was just uh, he was
7141 like, yelling at me to like, help him wrap it around her head, her, something
7142 I guess um, j-, cut pieces are comin' off or somethin' like that on her.
- 7143 Martin: Okay.
- 7144 CM: I was in and out of the room like, a lot.
- 7145 Martin: Okay. Alright. Still goin' on that adrenalin rush there, eh?
- 7146 CM: Don't want anything to do with it, but y'know, I don't wanna freak him out
7147 'cause like, what the fuck.
- 7148 Martin: Yeah. Oh no, it's, no that's understandable. Um, so when she's all taped
7149 up, what happens then?
- 7150 CM: I'm not gonna say. Again, this is privileged.
- 7151 Martin: Well, y-you see, the, the, the a-and I know that there, there's a whole
7152 bunch of, and, and I see it from you that there's a whole bunch of reasons
7153 for this, right? That there's a whole bunch of, and, and you said it a whole
7154 bunch of times to Mark and I today, you said, y'know, it's tough to go uh,
7155 for you to completely understand because of these other things that are
7156 happening. But, but, y'know-
- 7157 CM: I don't know if you were in the room over there, or whatever, and heard
7158 what I said to Mark, there are five words that I could blow your like, how
7159 you think everything here was prepared.
- 7160 Martin: Uh-huh.
- 7161 CM: Like um, the preplanning, everything like that. You have to know Kruse
7162 first to understand how I've come to the conclusion of my five word
7163 summary.
- 7164 Martin: Okay.

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7165 CM: And then there, of course, are the five words that I'm not gonna disclose
7166 right now.

7167 Martin: Okay.

7168 CM: But, it is, you would never see it in a million years. Is that I could ever see
7169 you guys comin' to the conclusion of.

7170 Martin: So you say this is a five word conclusion of why all of this took place?

7171 CM: The preplanning thing is.

7172 Martin: Just the preplanning part?

7173 CM: The, how everything, how I led up to be in this situation where I'm at
7174 Kruse's house-

7175 Martin: Yeah.

7176 CM: -with the two people.

7177 Martin: It comes down to five, five simple words?

7178 CM: Five words.

7179 Martin: Wow.

7180 CM: But, you have to understand Kruse and how it can come to this
7181 conclusion, which you can only get by really knowing Kruse.

7182 Martin: Okay. So, h-h-, so what you're sayin' to me is that um, huh, okay, so that,
7183 because of it, because of your knowledge of Kruse, and, and how things
7184 come about-

7185 CM: In his head. You don't really know how it work but you get a gist of-

7186 Martin: Okay. I mean, you know him the best, I guess.

7187 CM: Mmm, you think. (Chuckles)

7188 Martin: Right. So, that comes down to a situation of all this preplanning comes
7189 down to a five word solution.

7190 CM: Yeah, how I-

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7191 Martin: I-I-I mean, I almost got-

7192 CM: -how I got dragged into all of this. (Chuckles)

7193 Martin: -into all of that, yeah. Well, I, that's what I'm striving to understand like, I

7194 mean, how do, how do five simple words put you in the middle of this

7195 whole thing?

7196 CM: Well, that's probably the reason that I can uh, a long time ago I had this

7197 really big problem, again I talked to Mark about how a couple of years ago

7198 I was d-, um, diagnosed as manic-depressive.

7199 Martin: Okay.

7200 CM: And then I was undiagnosed with manic-depressive because I found a

7201 way to um, control-

7202 Martin: Mm-hm.

7203 CM: -in th-the changing moods because like, um, there's ... manic-depressive-

7204 Martin: Yes.

7205 CM: I don't know if you know that-

7206 Martin: Yes, I-I have actually y'know, and-and um, Mark had told you that we

7207 learn about this in polygraph school, so.

7208 CM: Mmm, yeah, manic-depressive changes over a long period of time. So,

7209 like, I could have months where I'm just you know, the best mood you've

7210 ever seen-

7211 Martin: Yeah. And months of doldrums.

7212 CM: -like high, high in the sky and then you know, you might as well be six feet

7213 under the dirt, I'm down and depressed.

7214 Martin: Mm-hm.

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7215 CM: Anyways, I was taking this medicine, it j-, wasn't working and um, I did
7216 some self-reflection eventually, I got rid of a lot of my old possessions, and
7217 stuff like this.

7218 Martin: Okay.

7219 CM: I had decided, hey, I'm gonna, gonna join the military, my brother's doing
7220 it and etcetera, etcetera, etcetera.

7221 Mark: Yeah.

7222 CM: And um, as I got rid of all these old possessions that had a lot of uh,
7223 negative emotions to me and I was able to, I don't know, cleanse myself of
7224 the anxiety, everything like that that I had been experiencing.

7225 Martin: Mm-hm, mm-hm.

7226 CM: Um, like now, well, yesterday, as you weren't here for this but um, I could
7227 keep a smile on my face. They said, it's not normal that you're not
7228 shedding tears etcetera, etcetera, etcetera. And it's because I have that
7229 control over myself now –

7230 Martin: Yeah.

7231 CM: -from years of knowin' what it is ... all over the place.

7232 Martin: Yeah, yeah.

7233 CM: So, it's not that I don't feel remorse or uh, f-, extremely horrible for what
7234 happened, it's just-

7235 Martin: That you're in control of where you need to be.

7236 CM: I don't want to, y'know, show the emotion, I don't wanna have to feel uh,
7237 all that bad stuff so I'm just tryin' to-

7238 Martin: Yeah.

7239 CM: -keep it in check.

7240 Martin: Okay. Well, thanks-

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7241 CM: So, it's not that I don't feel-

7242 Martin: -thanks for that.

7243 CM: -...

7244 Martin: Thanks for explaining. No, I know, I-I don't think I, I don't think that that's
7245 the case. And thanks for explaining that for me because you know it's,
7246 and it's important we talk to different people, right? And, and not
7247 everybody reacts the same way or shows those same emotions and, to
7248 have that understanding of you, Cam is a, is extremely important to me.
7249 Right? I'd asked Mark a little while ago to uh, find something for me here.
7250 I hope that he comes back soon but, okay um, so just getting back to this
7251 e-, uh and I can understand you wanting to be out of the room. Right?
7252 And, and you wanted to go and-and, and distance yourself from this
7253 because it, it is something that's happening that a-and your explanation,
7254 what you just told me is probably thinkin', no, no this, this isn't that, that
7255 good thing. Right? It's-it's not.

7256 CM: I don't think it is.

7257 Martin: But then it moves onto the, the second phase, right? From that unlawful
7258 confinement moves towards that, that sexual assault component. Right?
7259 Which includes that, that brutalization. So, y-, I've told you that, in that
7260 your linked via DNA as well. Right?

7261 CM: To the brutalization?

7262 Martin: To, to the sexual assault.

7263 CM: Yes.

7264 Martin: Like, I, I-I mean, now we're gonna compartmentalize that, like, I mean,
7265 sexual assault and brutalization, I-I-I mean, one and the same, right?
7266 That's s-s-semantics. Um, because i-i-it, you know, you can have

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7267 brutalization by um, just uh, punching and kicking and, and, and
7268 hammering a-and causing that physical injury but adding that sexual
7269 component to it as well,I, I mean, uh, d-, that happens. So, you're tied via
7270 DNA to that, right? 'Cause I did tell you that your DNA was found inside of
7271 her. So, I, I mean w-walking through where, where we've gone here and
7272 understanding your role in, in the unlawful confinement is uh, you know, i-
7273 it paints a clearer picture. How does it get to that next stage? How does it
7274 get to that sexual assault component that ties you via DNA?
7275 CM: Kruse.
7276 Martin: Okay.
7277 CM: But, as I explained to you, I don't know what the fuck's goin' through his
7278 mind anywhere because I didn't ever see this occurring-
7279 Martin: Okay.
7280 CM: -actually occur.
7281 Martin: Right.
7282 CM: Like uh, oh God. This is, this is the whole (laughs) big picture thing now.
7283 Without giving away my whole big thing.
7284 Martin: Mm-hm.
7285 CM: Um, we'd use gas for the other things, I didn't exactly dig in, I never seen
7286 this actually occurring.
7287 Martin: Mm-hm.
7288 CM: It's, I've used a gas for many things like, uh, Kruse tried to do drugs with
7289 gas one time.
7290 Martin: Yeah. And I understand that, white fuel is used for methamphetamines
7291 and-
7292 CM: Not methamphetamines ...

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7293 Martin: Right.

7294 CM: Uh, dimeth-, e-, dimethyltryptamine.

7295 Martin: Okay.

7296 CM: Um, do you know what that is?

7297 Martin: No, I don't.

7298 CM: Um, DMT, it's produced in your pineal gland.

7299 Martin: Okay.

7300 CM: That's what makes you dream.

7301 Martin: DMD.

7302 CM: DMT.

7303 Martin: DMT. Okay. Okay. So, you'd used that for that before, okay.

7304 CM: It's-

7305 Martin: So, this is part of it.

7306 CM: .-...

7307 Martin: Okay, I get it. Okay, so continue on, sorry.

7308 CM: Um, it's pertinent to the whole big story, I just thought I would share that

7309 with you.

7310 Martin: Sure. Okay, so uh, but how does it get to that other component where it,

7311 where you're tied via DNA and the sexual assault?

7312 CM: Oh, via DNA I um, I was basically told to.

7313 Martin: Okay. And what were you told to do?

7314 CM: This, I told you earlier, that there's this one thing that makes me believe

7315 that Kruse would do this to myself, right?

7316 Martin: Okay.

7317 CM: And that's part of that and it's part of what I'm not gonna say right now,

7318 but.

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- 7319 Martin: Okay. So, what are you told, though?
- 7320 CM: If I tell you his exact wording like, quote unquote um, uh, then you'd
- 7321 understand the whole part that makes me believe you. I'm not gonna,
- 7322 ready to say that now.
- 7323 Martin: Okay, so paraphrase that.
- 7324 CM: N-, basically I was told to.
- 7325 Martin: Okay.
- 7326 CM: This is just the gist of it.
- 7327 Martin: Okay. When you say what you were told to do, what were you told to do?
- 7328 CM: The words that he uses indicated that I was supposed to um, have sexual
- 7329 relations.
- 7330 Martin: Okay, so in-in paraphrasing, let's get away from the words that, 'cause,
- 7331 uh, the q-, the quote unquote. So, p-, e-, paraphrase that for me. So, if
- 7332 you were saying in your own words, what would that be?
- 7333 CM: The gist, like, the whole gist of anything that he said during this period.
- 7334 Martin: Mm-hm.
- 7335 CM: Um, was instructing me to do it repeatedly. Like, I'm, not didn't do it
- 7336 repeatedly but um-
- 7337 Martin: He was telling you repeatedly to do it.
- 7338 CM: Yeah.
- 7339 Martin: Okay. Alright. So, what does he tell y-, what is the act that he tells you to
- 7340 do?
- 7341 CM: Whatever I want, basically.
- 7342 Martin: Okay.
- 7343 CM: In the sexual manner.
- 7344 Martin: In a sexual manner. He, so he tells you to perform a sexual act?

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7345 CM: Yeah.

7346 Martin: Okay. And, and he tells you whatever. So, which sexual act do you
7347 choose at that time?

7348 CM: Mmm, stick to the basics. (Chuckles)

7349 Martin: Okay. And what's the basics?

7350 CM: You know where it is.

7351 Martin: Yeah.

7352 CM: Obviously.

7353 Martin: So, what's the basics for you? But I don't wanna put words in your mouth,
7354 like I s-said.

7355 CM: I know you don't wanna put words in my mouth.

7356 Martin: So, what's the basics for you?

7357 CM: Um, I was just normal. The n-, the, not that none of, any of this is normal
7358 but-

7359 Martin: Okay. So a-a-and you tell me if I'm wrong, but when you say normal, you
7360 would uh, I would take that to mean that you placed your penis in her
7361 vagina. Is that what you call normal?

7362 CM: Yeah, that would be normal for me.

7363 Martin: Okay. So-

7364 CM: And it would be normal for most people I ...-

7365 Martin: So, right. Okay, so just, on that, he says to you um, he's-, he's telling you
7366 repeatedly to do it-

7367 CM: Okay, I'll just tell you. Quote, unquote, he says, if I'm gonna incriminate
7368 myself in this, you have to, too. Because he's already done all this stuff
7369 and, y'know, I-, as I've told you I'm stayin' away, stayin' away, stayin'
7370 away.

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7371 Martin: Yeah. Okay.

7372 CM: And, you know at one point he like, shuts me in his room with her and he's
7373 like, do it, and I'm like, I'm not ... etcetera, etcetera, etcetera, and-

7374 Martin: Yeah.

7375 CM: -eventually he's just like, screaming and stuff and won't even close the
7376 door and he's like, fuckin', he's nuts. (Chuckles)

7377 Martin: Yeah.

7378 CM: So-

7379 Martin: So, d'you think Kruse has lost it by this time?

7380 CM: T-, I'd bloody well lost it like, I don't know what the hell's goin' on.

7381 Martin: Yeah. Okay. So-

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7459 Martin: And Kruse, yeah, sorry, you're right, you said that, if I'm gonna incriminate
7460 myself, you're gonna incriminate yourself, too. So what does, how does
7461 that blend in to everything that we've talked about today?

7462 CM: Th-that's, that's just my point is like, he wanted nothing to be untouched,
7463 that I wasn't, y'know, a bigger part of than him.

7464 Martin: Yeah.

7465 CM: Th-that's just what makes me realize exactly what you guys were talking
7466 about before is just, y'know, he's freaking out and-

7467 Martin: Mm-hm.

7468 CM: -saying whatever and.

7469 Martin: Yeah.

7470 CM: Kruse knows I'm bigger than him, knows I'm stronger than him, me and
7471 him have actually gotten into a physical al-altercation once. And he knows
7472 that I will defend myself, or whatever.

7473 Martin: Yeah.

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7474 CM: Like uh, this was a long time ago out in front of like, Walmart or something
7475 uh, he went and spat in my like, towards my face. Anyways um, it ended
7476 up was that I took control. I put him in a headlock and basically you don't
7477 do that and.

7478 Martin: Mm-hm.

7479 CM: I didn't wanna like, hurt him or anything like, he's like, I know you coulda
7480 like, broken my teeth, my nose. Like, I'm a-

7481 Martin: Yeah.

7482 CM: -big guy. And he was even smaller at the time.

7483 Martin: Mm-hm.

7484 CM: Like, I've been in, I've been in fights. I was, the only time I've ever like,
7485 actually like, hit people is um, twice, which was with Kruse and this other
7486 guy he was beating the crap out of his girlfriend and lit her hair on fire and
7487 stuff.

7488 Martin: Yeah. Yeah. Um-

7489 CM: And like, each time I've, I've never used my full force 'cause I'm fully
7490 capable of-

7491 Martin: Yeah.

7492 CM: -y'know, destroying somebody.

7493 Martin: Mm-hm.

7494 CM: Like, to put it short like, uh-

7495 Martin: Yeah. Um, so getting back to uh, what you said and then, and you-you
7496 talked to me about uh, so you did, you did it the normal way. I know you,
7497 y'know, you kinda covered that off that you, you put your penis in her
7498 vagina. Um, how do you know like, I-I-I mean, that's the way, right? Like,
7499 I mean, it confirms for you uh, the DNA findings. Right? You know on, on

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7500 the sexual assault component. Um, now DNA wise we talked about skin,
7501 and semen and, and blood and hair and things like that. Uh, so what do
7502 you think the source of the DNA was?
7503 CM: Pro-probably be semen or um, yeah, semen is the um, I'm not sure what
7504 the actual medical term is but there's um, pre-ejaculation ...-
7505 Martin: Right.
7506 CM: -so just like a lubricated, it does sometimes contain DNA.
7507 Martin: Yeah. Yeah. How long did it take you to ejaculate?
7508 CM: I don't even think I did. Like, the, like I said, the pre-cum does um, have
7509 stuff released into it, it's possible to get pregnant from it. Um, anyways I
7510 di-, wasn't doing that for more than like, three minutes, four minutes
7511 'cause-
7512 Martin: O-okay.
7513 CM: -it's not something I wanted to be part of. It's just, y'know-
7514 Martin: Yeah.
7515 CM: -he's d-, run like, not running, but he's, y'know, strutting around the house
7516 like, yelling to himself. He's like, y'know-
7517 Martin: What kinds of things was he-
7518 CM: -this just happened, y'know, oh, we're havin' fun all of a sudden.
7519 Martin: Right. Yeah. Um-
7520 CM: So, it's the fight or flight thing. It's like, y'know, listen and maybe I'll get,
7521 you know, through this and nothing will come of it and (chuckles)-
7522 Martin: Yeah. Yeah. So, that's what's goin' through your head at that time?
7523 CM: Is self-preservation.

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7524 Martin: Yeah. Yeah. Yeah, I can see that. So, three or four minutes um, that
7525 you're having intercourse with her um, and what's Kruse doing at that
7526 time?
7527 CM: Coming in or out of the room, ranting-
7528 Martin: While, while you're having intercourse with her he's coming in and out of
7529 the room?
7530 CM: Well, yeah, he wants to make sure I'm doin' it and he's, like I told you, he's
7531 telling me repeatedly even after um, he-he's like, I'm not gonna leave until
7532 you start.
7533 Martin: Okay.
7534 CM: And so he's, in and out of the room-
7535 Martin: Yeah, and just to confirm there, Cam, at the time that you're having sex
7536 with her, she's alive?
7537 CM: Yeah.
7538 Martin: Okay.
7539 CM: And, and I told you I'm not-
7540 Martin: Yeah.
7541 CM: -...
7542 Martin: Yeah, you're not into that? So, at the time that you're having sex with her,
7543 she is alive.
7544 CM: I wouldn't do that if you put a gun to my head. (Chuckles)
7545 Martin: Okay. Okay. Good. I, and I was, wanted to make sure. Right? So, after
7546 you have sex with her, what happens?
7547 CM: I left the room.
7548 Martin: Okay.

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7549 CM: No gonna, not, that was like, enough. Enough. Like, if I get told to do like,
7550 much more I'm gonna turn around and then beat the shit out of him. And
7551 just like, run out of the house.

7552 Martin: Okay. So, what do you do?

7553 CM: I left the room. I went and sat in the living room just, the TV was on and
7554 just sittin' there whole heartedly for-, tryin' to forget what's happening and
7555 uh, watching the TV, just watching the TV. Nothing else. Not thinking, not
7556 talking, I can't even say I was breathing, I was just watching the TV with all
7557 my concentration.

7558 Martin: Okay. And what room was Kim in at the time?

7559 CM: I believe Kruse's.

7560 Martin: Kruse's room? Okay. That's where you had sex with her is in his room?

7561 CM: Yeah.

7562 Martin: Okay. And now, you talked about him saying, if I'm gonna incriminate
7563 myself, you're gonna incriminate yourself, too. So, did he have sex with
7564 her first? Sorry?

7565 CM: Yeah.

7566 Martin: Okay. He had sex with her first. And then you had sex with her. Did he
7567 have sex with her again?

7568 CM: I'll just say that, I'm not gonna like, go and specify right now-

7569 Martin: Yeah.

7570 CM: -but um, repeatedly.

7571 Martin: Repeatedly. Over a period of, what kind of period?

7572 CM: I can't say.

7573 Martin: Uh, about?

7574 CM: I don't know, hours, two hours, three hours. I don't know.

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7575 Martin: Okay. And during this whole time, she's in a position where uh, she has
7576 the sock in her mouth uh, the duct tape on her lower, on this lower part,
7577 the bag over her head?

7578 CM: No bag. That was later, part of the asphyxiation thing th-that we-we talked
7579 about.

7580 Martin: Okay. Can you clarify that for me then? So, wh-when you're having sex
7581 with her-

7582 CM: There was no bag.

7583 Martin: There was not bag. It was just um-

7584 CM: The sock.

7585 Martin: -the sock in her mouth?

7586 CM: Yes.

7587 Martin: And the tape here? But when did, i-i-i and uh, were there bindings at that
7588 time?

7589 CM: Um, mm-, I'm trying to be accurate-

7590 Martin: Yeah.

7591 CM: -here for you.

7592 Martin: Absolutely.

7593 CM: I can say yes for her hands um, I'm not sure about her feet.

7594 Martin: Okay. So, I-I just wanna get that, that order right. Okay? So, I'm gonna
7595 go back to it. Obviously Kim's at, is at the residence with the two of you.
7596 Um, does it go off as the, as the plan? I'm gonna make KD. And that's
7597 when the attack starts?

7598 CM: Uh, no.

7599 Martin: Okay. How does it go off?

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7600 CM: (Sighs) I'm not gonna really get into this. It's j-, a long, long, long process
7601 that uh, I, I don't even wanna remember.

7602 Martin: I'm just gonna come back to that comment, if I'm gonna incriminate
7603 myself, you're going to incriminate yourself, too.

7604 CM: Yeah.

7605 Martin: Okay, now I just wanna come back to that. Going through it, and then
7606 yes, him saying that he's gonna say, I'm gonna make KD, I'm gonna
7607 attack her, but implicating you into, you're gonna be in my mom's room
7608 coming in. Right? So, I wanna make sure that you're telling me now that
7609 that doesn't happen that way. So, uh, uh, I-I wanna be accurate as to
7610 what does occur there.

7611 CM: I-I, (sighs) it's part of my five.

7612 Martin: Five words?

7613 CM: Yeah.

7614 Martin: Okay. What are those, those five words? I-I-I'm s-striving to understand,
7615 Cam.

7616 CM: I know. It is, I've, I'm, I'm not gonna tell you is what the five words are
7617 'cause that's the whole big shebang and thing. Where'd the other guy go,
7618 anyways?

7619 Martin: Uh, I asked him to find something for me (chuckles) and it may be a little
7620 bit obscure in the volumes of information that we have, so. But, the thing
7621 is is that you've uh, made great strides here today. And-and I, I, I said to
7622 you that it's all about your, your integrity. Right? And, and I wanna know,
7623 that's why I wanna know that portion, right? Because i-, okay i-, without
7624 you mentioning those five words, 'cause I, that, that whole situation, I, I
7625 understand that's something that's kinda troubling to you. Um-

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- 7626 CM: This whole thing's kinda troubling to me.
- 7627 Martin: No, I-I know that, (chuckles) I know that, Cam. But, in-in going in there I
7628 wanna maintain that accuracy that we've established so far. And uh, how
7629 did, y'know, how does that point come into play? Because that plan is, is,
7630 is made to look as that yeah, okay I'm gonna attack but you're gonna be
7631 right there to support that attack. Right? That's, that's what's written,
7632 that's what we've gone over.
- 7633 CM: (Sighs) Yeah, okay. Let's say Kruse has his plan, okay? His plan that I
7634 don't know with the whole incriminating me in the plan.
- 7635 Martin: Okay.
- 7636 CM: This um, where is that? Anyways, have it all the, you hide in my mom's
7637 room, blah, blah, blah-
- 7638 Martin: Yeah.
- 7639 CM: -blah, blah, blah, blah.
- 7640 Martin: Yeah, for sure.
- 7641 CM: Is ju-, let's just say part of his plan. Um, it would uh, this would.
- 7642 Martin: Yeah.
- 7643 CM: Um, uh, I don't know. Um, that was like, y'know, him putting the duct tape
7644 somewhere and y'know, get it and I-I, th-, it's a supporting role.
- 7645 Martin: Okay.
- 7646 CM: I guess th-, was in his, he obviously had this a lot better planned than,
7647 well, I didn't have a plan. (Chuckles)
- 7648 Martin: Okay. So, he, how does it, how does it take off?
- 7649 CM: You're gonna realize if you look at my phone records there is the whole
7650 phone call with me and Kruse before any of this.
- 7651 Martin: Mm-hm. Mm-hm.

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7652 CM: Where he, he phones me up and that is a huge part of how it all leads into
7653 this, the whole five word thing-

7654 Martin: Okay, so what does he say in that conversation?

7655 CM: That would tell you everything on how it leads, y'know, from y'know, in
7656 probably an hour or two hours before your chart starts there to, y'know,
7657 right up to, y'know, the two messages right there.

7658 Martin: Mm-hm.

7659 CM: And you guys talked to my mom, right? Like, you, she was interviewed.

7660 Martin: Yeah.

7661 CM: And y'know, th-th-the big thing she said you guys didn't know is the why.
7662 The, apparently you stressed the why is uh, the only thing you guys can't
7663 get. Is why.

7664 Martin: Mm-hm. How come?

7665 CM: For Kruse? No clue. Oh, I have a clue but, my why is totally different than
7666 Kruse's why and Kruse's why is now, y'know, obstructed from my vision
7667 and what I was told.

7668 Martin: So um, how does that attack part start then?

7669 CM: With Kruse.

7670 Martin: Yeah.

7671 CM: Y'know, attacking. (Chuckles)

7672 Martin: Yeah.

7673 CM: (Sighs)

7674 Martin: I mean, it's, it's not something that happens extremely quietly. It's not
7675 happened, i-i-it's not something that i-, she's a willing participant to.

7676 CM: No.

7677 Martin: Right?

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7678 CM: Yeah.

7679 Martin: So, how does that take place?

7680 CM: That's again part of my whole big grand story.

7681 Martin: Okay.

7682 CM: (Sighs)

7683 Martin: Go ahead.

7684 CM: I don't wanna tell the story. (Chuckles) I, the, time and a place and

7685 y'know, this isn't the-

7686 Martin: So, i-

7687 CM: -right time or the right place.

7688 Martin: -so if, when you, okay look, that's, remove that-

7689 CM: ...

7690 Martin: -why or the how come there but, just as to actions that, that take place.

7691 Wh-when Kruse attacks her, what is Kim's reaction?

7692 CM: Um, nothing at first.

7693 Martin: Okay. Why is that?

7694 CM: I told you about the whole anatomical thing. Right? That Kruse went

7695 through.

7696 Martin: Yeah.

7697 CM: He still kinda is in um-

7698 Martin: Okay.

7699 CM: He expressed to me that he had um, oh, it renders him be unconscious

7700 that caused no physical harm or anything like that.

7701 Martin: Okay.

7702 CM: And it was due to um, ma-, cutting off circulation to a certain part of your

7703 brain for a, a short time.

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7704 Martin: Yeah.

7705 CM: And y'know, that's where a plan that wasn't really a plan, y'know, started
7706 to go well, no, I shouldn't say awfully wrong, 'cause it went awfully wrong
7707 well, before that but uh-

7708 Martin: I know what you're saying.

7709 CM: Um, y'know, no such thing. It doesn't, it doesn't or didn't work.

7710 Martin: Okay. So, what did he attempt to do?

7711 CM: Um, incapacitate. I would use the words-

7712 Martin: Okay. In-in what, in what fashion?

7713 CM: By um, however he was supposed to do it um, cutting the circulation off
7714 shortly.

7715 Martin: Okay. And-and what um, what is your understanding of how that took
7716 place?

7717 CM: Just him uh, I can't like, oh God. There's gonna be a time and a place one
7718 day when this is just gonna be so easy to tell this.

7719 Martin: Mm-hm.

7720 CM: Um, it-it just basically starts just, with the gist of it with him-

7721 Martin: Yeah.

7722 CM: -y'know unexpectedly just going up and starting.

7723 Martin: Okay. So, unexpectedly tr-, goin' to co-, like, going to come up and try to
7724 apply this technique that would render her unconscious for a short period
7725 of time. Fair to say?

7729 Martin: Okay. So that occurs, and obviously it goes off the rails. It doesn't work.
7730 Is that what you said?
7731 CM: Well, the idea was he was supposed to do this and then initially Duct Tape
7732 her and whatever else.
7733 Martin: Okay. So, it goes off the rails. So what, what oc- what occurs? Is there
7734 a-a struggle?
7735 CM: No. Kruse is obviously big enough and capable enough to keep things
7736 under control and that's just where I'm yelled at, even though I'm just
7737 standing there, y'know, shock and awe, mouth open, what the fuck.
7738 Y'know, it's after that the adrenalin. It's like getting hit by f-, like, I don't
7739 know, a tsunami just standing there and just, the whole pressure-
7740 Martin: Yeah.
7741 CM: -just hits you in your mind. Y-you're not even thinking, it's just like, all
7742 thoughts just gone.
7743 Martin: Yeah.
7744 CM: And it's just, y'know, when he starts yellin' at me to y'know, get Duct Tape
7745 or whatever, that he-
7746 Martin: Okay.
7747 CM: -asked.
7748 Martin: Okay. And where-where had he placed it?
7749 CM: Uh, the kitchen counter, I believe.
7750 Martin: The kitchen counter. Yeah, 'cause I remember you saying that he went to
7751 the ki-, y-, the, uh, it was on the counter. So, you get the Duct Tape and
7752 come back and then that's what you explained to me is-
7753 CM: I then tape her feet.

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- 7754 Martin: Okay. But, b-, before that in the room that you're in that this happens, and
7755 I would assume it's probably the living room?
- 7756 CM: I'm just not gonna say it but, th-th-that's the whole localized area it's a
7757 pretty small place-

- 7760 Martin: Yeah. Okay. So, it happens in, in one of the, and when I talk about the
7761 living room, I'm talking about common room not bedroom or anything like

7765 gather, all that small area there?
- 7766 CM: It's pretty small house.

7769 that, that occurs is e-, because you said to me it was to muffle sound, is
7770 that the sock goes into her mouth?
- 7771 CM: Um, after he figures out what he's gonna do isn't working?
- 7772 Martin: Yeah.
- 7773 CM: Yeah.
- 7774 Martin: Okay.
- 7775 CM: And he kind of, th-, he, it's, he has it when I get there.
- 7776 Martin: Okay. And then the first piece is a, a piece of cut Duct Tape-
- 7777 CM: No.
- 7778 Martin: -that you hand him? No?
- 7779 CM: That, that was the first that he applied over her mouth.

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7780 Martin: Okay. So, just so I get the sequencing right, the sock goes into her
7781 mouth, what happens next?

7782 CM: Feet first.

7783 Martin: Feet first. Sorry. Okay. Feet first. So, is she, is she screamin' and-and
7784 struggling at this time?

7785 CM: Um, not really.

7786 Martin: Okay.

7787 CM: Um, I don't know um, oh God, it's all a really big freakin' stupid story.
7788 (Sighs)

7789 Martin: Yeah.

7790 CM: That's basically what it is, the whole action, purpose, everything what
7791 happened, that it's stupid.

7792 Martin: Mm-hm. So, just so I get the sequencing right, though, you say the feet
7793 first?

7794 CM: Yeah.

7795 Martin: Okay. And then?

7796 CM: I don't know. I think he did her arms or whatever-

7797 Martin: Okay.

7798 CM: -her hands I should say.

7799 Martin: Yeah.

7800 CM: Next.

7801 Martin: Okay. And that was uh, in front of her body?

7802 CM: Behind.

7803 Martin: Behind. Okay. And then, sock in the mouth?

7804 CM: I believe so. And then um-

7805 Martin: Cut piece?

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7806 CM: Yeah.

7807 Martin: And then, after that you're pullin' off pieces?

7808 CM: Yeah, and then eventually I just handed him the roll and I'd hold it, y'know,
7809 every once in a while when he'd yell at me to come back or-

7810 Martin: Okay. And at that point it's taped from under the nose down to the chin.

7811 CM: Yes.

7812 Martin: Okay. Now, when she's in that state, is she struggling?

7813 CM: Um, I wasn't there, I didn't wanna be there. Yeah, I wasn't tryin' to pay
7814 attention to really what was happening. I know he like, asked me to get
7815 him hand soap or something or, I don't even know.

7816 Martin: Okay. Um, so from there, from that living area where, where is she taken
7817 to?

7818 CM: I don't know. She was, (sighs), oh, God. I don't even really want to,
7819 (chuckles), explain it. Um, I don't know. She was moved about, (sighs), is
7820 just all what it is.

7821 Martin: She was moved about how many times?

7822 CM: I don't know. Um, not that many. Um, just uh, m-, he moved her from
7823 various place to various place.

7824 Martin: Okay. So, after that, that initial shock and awe, that you said-

7825 CM: The whole thing was kinda ...-

7826 Martin: No, I-I understand-

7827 CM: -...-

7828 Martin: -but the initial shock and awe, and then, a-and then it, and then it happens
7829 um, and she's moved um, so the unlawful confinement part is, is
7830 happening um, then she's sexually assaulted by Kruse?

7831 CM: Yeah. I guess. I wasn't in the room.

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7832 Martin: Okay, well when, okay. With feet taped and, and at one point you, I mean,
7833 you had sexual intercourse with her. So, with feet taped and with hands
7834 taped behind her body um, how do her clothes get removed?
7835 CM: I really don't even wanna explain it right now. It's-
7836 Martin: Okay.
7837 CM: -kinda makin' me nauseous. (Chuckles)
7838 Martin: Be-, because okay. A-and, a-and, I don't want that to happen but um, at
7839 one point d-did you say that the, the tape came off the feet?
7840 CM: Yeah, I think uh, that he made me cut it off.
7841 Martin: He made you cut it off? Okay. So uh, Kruse has sex with her um, when
7842 you have sex with her what clothing does she have on and what clothing
7843 does she not have on? Like, what's she, what, what is it, (sighs), that's a
7844 stupid question. (Chuckles) What state is she in of, what state of dress is
7845 she in when you have sex with her?
7846 CM: Nothing, I guess.
7847 Martin: Completely nude.
7848 CM: I guess.
7849 Martin: Okay.
7850 CM: As far as I can recall.
7851 Martin: And did you remove her clothing? Or did Kruse?
7852 CM: Um, mostly Kruse. I was just instructed to get a knife so we could cut it
7853 off.
7854 Martin: Okay. So he cut off her clothes? Okay. Is that because of the bindings?
7855 CM: I guess. (Sighs) I guess, if she's bound it's kinda hard to do.
7856 Martin: Yeah. So, where do you get that knife from?
7857 CM: The kitchen.

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7858 Martin: From the kitchen? Okay. Um, so, then she's sexually assaulted by Kruse.
7859 Uh, you have sex with her as well. Kruse comes back in. Uh, you leave
7860 the room, you're sitting in front of the TV um, you're just in kind of a state, I
7861 guess, is what you kinda described. What happens with Kim and Kruse at
7862 that time?

7863 CM: I don't even really wanna talk about that um, but uh, basically you have
7864 the gist of it. There's an overwhelming amount more. (Sighs)

7865 Martin: Yeah?

7866 CM: Before, during, after everything we've talked about.

7867 Martin: Yeah? Because there is whe-when we talked about the sexual assault
7868 component and that brutalization, there is a lot of stuff that goes on there,
7869 isn't there?

7870 CM: There's a lot of stuff for all of it like, um, you pretty well get this. Other
7871 than um, the fact that I was on the phone with him before this and
7872 everything. (Sighs) I don't know if you knew that I was on the phone to
7873 him before that but.

7874 Martin: Yeah. Well, your phone records show that, right? Um, so to cause those
7875 bruises and those uh, those broken bones that you, that you're talking
7876 about, you're, you assume that w-, there was broken bones, how is she
7877 struck? What was she struck with?

7878 CM: Uh, again, I'm not really gonna say, yet. Uh-

7879 Martin: Okay. Was she hit with fists?

7880 CM: Um, as far as I know Kruse was bodily, physically violent.

7881 Martin: Okay, so with fists then? Like, like-

7882 CM: Like, ...

7883 Martin: -when we say, when you say bodily violent, you mean by-

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7884 CM: Means not using something.

7885 Martin: -using a body. Not using something. So using his fists and his feet. Like,

7886 kicking and-

7887 CM: But I-I was told of more kinda gross things.

7888 Martin: Okay.

7889 CM: On-

7890 Martin: Okay, so what kinds of things that are gross that he told you?

7891 CM: Um, I'm not really gonna mention, there's just one really gross thing that

7892 sticks out in my mind that I do not wanna mention but it was probably the

7893 most disturbing by far. For me, anyways.

7894 Martin: Okay.

7895 CM: Not having seen the extent of, I'll use the quotations handiwork.

7896 Martin: Handiwork? So, he told you at one point that he performed some

7897 handiwork?

7898 CM: Um, not handiwork, it's, this is just when I'm using the word as handiwork.

7899 Martin: Okay.

7900 CM: I know that I, like I said, I spent a lot of time out of the room. So, I know of

7901 some deeds he may have or may not have performed.

7902 Martin: Okay. And that's during the sexual assault and brutalization?

7903 CM: And yeah.

7904 (Hour 9)

7905 Martin: Now let me ask you this, was he having sex with her while he was hitting

7906 her?

7907 CM: I wasn't stickin' around to see him.

7908 Martin: Well, what he's told you?

7909 CM: Um, he's told me a lot of things but. (Yawns)

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7910 Martin: Okay. Um-

7911 CM: So, what exactly are we waiting for you to get back?

7912 Martin: I was, I was waiting for Mark there but he's probably busy. Um, so, you
7913 say that Kruse did a, kind of a, I-I-I would call it a litany of things, uh a
7914 whole bunch of things to her. Um, from a, a brutalization stand point. You
7915 said that he was using physical violence and then you said that there was
7916 some, your quote, "handiwork" completed. Um, I-I mean, I-I've been a
7917 policeman a long time, right? Um, nothing is disturbing to me. Um-

7918 CM: Well, it's disturbing me. (Chuckles)

7919 Martin: It's unfortunate but that, I mean, that, that is the case. So when you say
7920 handiwork what, what's he eluding to then?

7921 CM: That he'd done stuff, that's just what I would say that he, it's-

7922 Martin: That he had done stuff-

7923 CM: It's his hand-

7924 Martin: Right, so something, something terrible to her body?

7925 CM: Yeah, I, of course, know what it is and-

7926 Martin: Yeah.

7927 CM: -don't really wanna say right now.

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8016 CM: -if somebody told me. But, they're five words all the same.
8017 Martin: Mm-hm. 'Kay, so after that handiwork is done, what occurs next?
8018 CM: Well, sorry it was six words, I did correct myself with Mark.
8019 Martin: (Chuckles) Now you're gonna make me guess six instead of five.
8020 CM: Yeah, no, what, how does it keep goin' up? I guess it could be five, it
8021 could be six or seven depending on how you wanna word it.
8022 Martin: (Laughs) Okay. So after that what occurs?
8023 CM: Um, lots of stuff, I really don't want to get into it.
8024 Martin: Okay, why-
8025 CM: Like really.
8026 Martin: -is that? And, I mean, like you said, you've made some strides here,
8027 you've explained to me happened.
8028 CM: I just want you guys to know that-
8029 Martin: Yeah.
8030 CM: -what I'm tellin' you is the truth.
8031 Martin: Yeah.
8032 CM: And um, uh, to get a, so you understand that you'll, no matter what I tell
8033 you from like, when I tell you the whole big thing, that no matter what, you
8034 have some key points that I cannot change. That I can not dis-involve
8035 myself from-
8036 Martin: Yeah.

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8037 CM: -due to evidence-

8038 Martin: Yeah.

8039 CM: -and my own say so.

8040 Martin: Yeah, and, a-a-a-and I told you this, right? We all own a role. Right? And

8041 when co-, when we commit that offence, you'll, y-y-you're tactical, you

8042 don't, you won't ...-

8043 CM: Yeah, so by all means-

8044 Martin: Yeah.

8045 CM: -don't put words in my mouth-

8046 Martin: No.

8047 CM: -'cause that will compromise, even if I do say something later uh, when

8048 you quote unquote would say, a calculated time-

8049 Martin: Yeah.

8050 CM: -i-it still compromises the integrity of what I'm saying whether you choose

8051 to believe it or not.

8052 Martin: Mm-hm. So, what you're telling me is if, you're, you're telling me portions

8053 of the truth here?

8054 CM: The truth doesn't come in portions. I'm telling you the truth, I'm just not

8055 telling you every single little thing that happened down to the tiniest grain

8056 of detail that I can come up with in my mind.

8057 Martin: Mm-hm.

8058 CM: And trust me, there's a lot of really disgusting, like-

8059 Martin: Why can't you bring yourself to talk about that?

8060 CM: Because I'm, (sighs), I can't say.

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8061 Martin: Y-you've been, okay and I'm not playin' on words, you can't say why you
8062 can't commit to saying those things? Internally, like is it, is something
8063 inside of you that won't allow you to do that?
8064 CM: Yes and no.
8065 Martin: This is-
8066 CM: There's multiple reasons and neither I will state.
8067 Martin: (Chuckles) Okay, that's complex.
8068 CM: I'm a weird dude.
8069 Martin: Mmm. Okay. So, there's a whole bunch of things that happened at the
8070 house that are uh, disturbing, that are-
8071 CM: Yeah, disturbing's a good way to put it.
8072 Martin: What other word would you-
8073 CM: Watching, y'know, snuffx.com's disturbing.
8074 Martin: Sorry?
8075 CM: Watching something that have been sent off like, snuffx.com is disturbing,
8076 this is-
8077 Martin: Okay, so what other words would you use to qualify what, what occurred
8078 there?
8079 CM: Oh God, you don't have words to describe exactly how I felt. (Chuckles)
8080 Like, there's no words in the English language-
8081 Martin: Okay well, I said disturbing, so what would you say?
8082 CM: Like I said, there, y-, uh, you can only draw the line so far with disturbing,
8083 horrendous, gruesome ...-
8084 Martin: Horrific.
8085 CM: Completely disgusting uh, horrifying.
8086 (Background - Knock on door)

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8517 Martin: I want you to focus on, what I was tryin' to say is I'm trying to f-, I want you
8518 to focus on the big chunks. Right? Of the things you-you can remember.
8519 Now those, those do exist, those are the ones that like, that you're going
8520 to get uh, okay here's what kinda happens next. And then all the details
8521 might be fuzzy and we can work those in afterwards, that's, that's, that's
8522 not a big deal. But you're on the couch and, and we're talking about
8523 component wise as we went through it, right? We're talking about the
8524 unlawful confinement um, the sexual assault, and now we're talking about
